### Today's Game at a Glance

Bowling Green Ballpark hosts the Bowling Green Hot Rods for their next six games, including three contests against the West Michigan Whitecaps (Tigers). The Hot Rods return to South Central Kentucky after defeating the Clinton LumberKings (Mariners) in a three-game set in Iowa. This season, no team in the Midwest League has more home victories than Bowling Green's 12 wins. **Season Series:** The Hot Rods lead the Whitecaps 3-1 in this season's 17-game series.

**LHP Blake Snell**, 20, will get his first opportunity to face West Michigan in his career. Drafted 52nd overall in the 2011 MLB Draft in the supplemental first round, Snell has not allowed an earned run in two of his last three appearances. *Baseball America* considers Snell the ninth-best prospect in the Rays system, right behind 2011 Hot Rod Enny Romero, the publication's top-ranked southpaw in the Tampa Bay organization.

**LHP Jordan John**, 22, is still in search of his first professional victory. The Hot Rods have already denied one of John's opportunities after defeating him and the Whitecaps 4-2 on April 13 at Bowling Green Ballpark. John was taken in the sixth round of last year's MLB Draft out of the University of Oklahoma, where he was a 2012 All-Big 12 Second Team pick.

### On Deck

The first Hot Rods homestand in the month of May will continue with a three-game series against the Lake County Captains (Indians). Bowling Green's next road trip will be a seven-game swing including visits with the Fort Wayne TinCaps (Padres) and the West Michigan Whitecaps (Tigers).

#### Ames Cruises in Career Outing, Hot Rods Win Series

Bowling Green takes Clinton two games to one

Clinton, IA – RHP Jeff Ames pitched personal-best six shutout innings to lead the Bowling Green Hot Rods (20-10) to a 4-2 victory in the rubber match against the Clinton LumberKings (13-15) at Ashford University Field on Monday. Ames now leads the Hot Rods with four victories, a mark that is also tied for the Midwest League lead through Monday afternoon's action. Andrew Toles highlighted four multi-hit efforts by Hot Rod batters with an RBI triple and a double in the series-clinching win.

### Spare Parts

**"A" FOR APRIL:** April 2013 marked the best start in Hot Rods history. Bowling Green set new team records for wins during the month of April (18) and best winning percentage in any month (.750). The Hot Rods also had a series record of six wins and two ties, marking the first time ever that Bowling Green did not lose a series within a calendar month.

**CHART TOPPERS:** Bowling Green is in first place in a plethora of statistics within the Midwest League. Offensively, the Hot Rods top the league with 18 triples, 50 stolen bases, and 1,007 at bats. Bowling Green pitchers lead the MWL in wins (20), ERA (2.91), and shutouts (four). The Hot Rods have also caught a league-high 18 would-be base stealers.

**"READY, 'AMES', FIRE":** RHP Jeff Ames is dominating Midwest League competition this season. Ames is currently first in the MWL with four wins, an opposing batting average of .151, and a 0.61 WHIP (walks plus hits per inning pitched) that leads all of affiliated baseball. Those marks are also in the top ten among all minor league pitchers.

**COOL HAND LUKE:** Hot Rods catcher Luke Maile is currently on an impressive hitting streak. While the streak is just six games long, Maile's streak started with a team-best four consecutive multi-hit performances. Maile is 12-of-25 (.480) with two doubles, and hit his first Hot Rods home run during this hitting streak.

**NEW FIELD GENERAL:** New Hot Rods Manager Jared Sandberg is just the third manager in team history and is the first ex-Major Leaguer to lead Bowling Green. Sandberg spent three seasons with the Devil Rays from 2001-2003 and hit 25 home runs over that stretch (.221 average). After leading Hudson Valley to the 2012 New York-Penn League crown, Sandberg was named the 2012 Short-Season Manager of the Year by *Baseball America*.
